


SETTING UP THE 5215F5

Make sure to place your fountain on a firm area which will not settle. Note: Always follow local electrical codes and use a 110V GFCI protected outlet.

- 1) As you begin assembling your new fountain, give serious attention to making sure the setting it will rest on is stable in weather conditions, flat, and level, since this is a tall vertical sculpture.
- 2) Place the 7216 Medium Pedestal in the center of your site with the access hole closest to the power source. Level as necessary.
- 3) Set the 6216 Lion Face Bowl on the medium pedestal. Place the pump inside the bowl and slip its power cord down through the hole in the center of the bowl and out the access hole of the pedestal as shown. Then, select the Stopper which has the smaller hole (1/4") to close up the hole in the bowl. Open the slit in the stopper and close it around the pump cord. Press the stopper down tightly into the hole in the bowl to make it water tight.
- 4) Thread the barbed adapter into the pump. Attach the water tube to the adapter's barb end.
- 5) Lower the 7215 Riser into the bowl and place it around the pump, holding the tube up through the riser as you lower it.
- 6) With help, lower the 6215 Bowl/Pedestal Unit onto the riser, pushing the water tube up through the bottom hole in the bowl/pedestal unit as you lower it. Gently pull the water tube above the bowl/pedestal unit until it is tight. Then open the slit in the other rubber stopper, place around the tube inside the bowl/pedestal, and press down into the hole to make it water tight.
- 7) Lower the 5215 Finial into the top bowl, slipping the water tube up into the finial as you do.
- 8) Read your pump instructions. Add water to the fountain and start your pump. If your pump does not push water immediately, there may be an airlock. Simply unplug and plug back in a few times and this will clear.



IMPORTANT – WINTER CARE

Winter ice build-up can cause damage to concrete statuary. Follow these tips to reduce winter weathering to your fountain:

- * Disconnect power to pumps and lights.
- * Remove plugs/stoppers in all fountain bowls to open drains and let all moisture out. Keep drains open throughout winter.
- * Place an absorbant material like burlap, blankets, etc. inside vases/bowls and cover all with a Henri fountain cover.
- * Do not allow snow or ice to build up on or against the concrete. Remove snow before it turns to ice. Do not use antifreeze, salt or chemical ice removers as these may damage concrete.
